


REPORT OF THE SCIENTIFIC ADVICE COMMISSION OF RESEARCH CENTRE IN ACCOUNTING AND TAXATION

- Considering that the Research Centre in Accounting and Taxation (RCAT) is organized on two central research lines: Accounting and Taxation;
- Considering the significant growth in the number of PhD, since the last 3 years, in the scientific areas of the centre;
- Considering that some members are yet integrated in doctoral programmes, which predict the potential growth of the RCAT in the short-term;
- Considering the members involvement in scientific activities and the growth in scientific publications (peer-reviewed journals and books) in the RCAT domain;
- Considering the scientific activities in which RCAT is participating, like the organization of the CIGAR Workshop (*Comparative International Governmental Accounting Research*), in 2012, and the AECA Encuentro (*Asociación Española de Contabilidad y Administración de Empresas*), to be place in 2012;

The Scientific Advice Commission, within its competences, gives its consent about the scientific activities in which the RCAT is involved and participating, considering that it was crucial to orient the centre in to research lines: Accounting and Taxation. The Commission also recognizes the potential growth of CIGAR in the short term, based on the high number of PhDs who have completed or are completing their doctoral programmes.
